



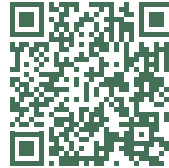

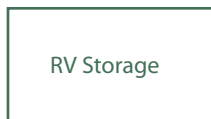

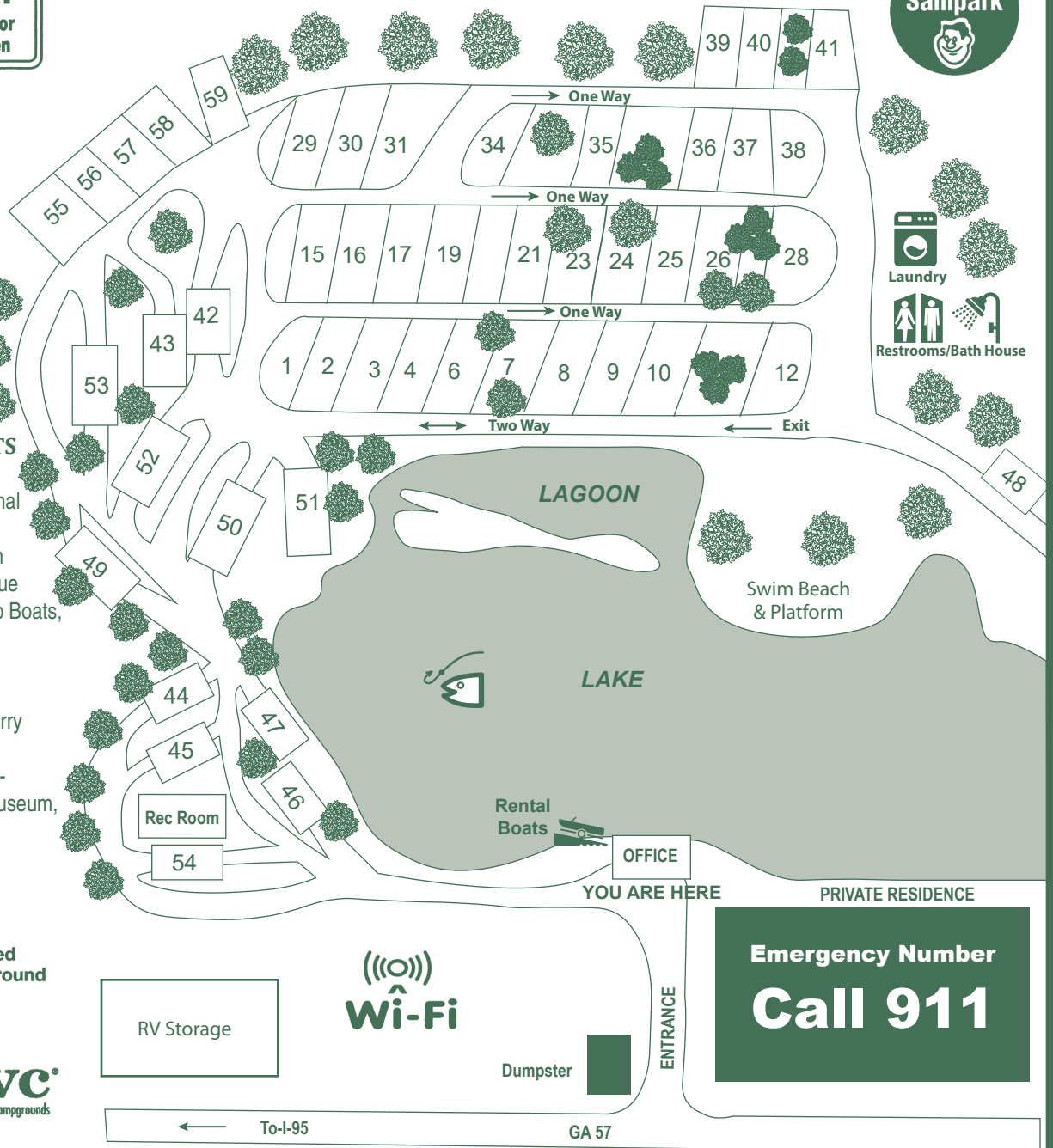

**PARK INFORMATION**

- **CHECK-OUT TIME:** Check out time is 11:00 AM.
- **OFFICE HOURS:** 9:00 AM TO 6:00 PM.
- **VISITORS:** Must register at office. A fee will be charged for guests staying overnight, fishing or swimming. all guests and vistors must have a car pass.
- **LAUNDROMAT:** Open 24 hours (bath house location). Quarters available in office. Clotheslines not allowed.
- **FISHING:** Limit 3 bass, 5 bluegill. No fishing from swim beach or swim dock.
- **Washing Of Vehicles Or RVs:** Please check with office.
- **NO FLUSHING OF SEWER TANK.**
- **SITES AND PARKING:** Please use only one camping unit per site. Sewer donuts required on all sewer sites.
- **PETS:** Must be on a leash. Do not leave pets unattended or tied outside your rig. As a courtesy to all, please clean up after your pet. Pets are not allowed on swim beach.
- **TRASH:** Please dispose of household garbage only in the dumpster located near the entrance. Please, no appliances, oil, antifreeze, etc.
- **TO BE OF HELP:** Please report any facilities not in working order promptly, so we may correct the situation.

**BEFORE YOU BLOW YOUR BREAKER**

Take a minute to see how many AMPS you could be using in your RV's 30 or 50 AMP electrical systems. It's surprising how fast the AMPS add up which causes your breaker or the RV Park's breaker to "trip". Knowing the AMPS of all the electrical appliances in your RV can help you manage electrical use and prevent the inconvenience of "MY ELECTRICITY WENT OUT". This list is typical of electrical appliances used and the average AMPS required to operate them.

Battery Charger .....	7.0 AMPS
Air Conditioner 15,000 BTU .....	12.5 AMPS
Electric Water Heater 6 Gal. ....	12.5 AMPS
Microwave Oven .....	12.8 AMPS
Electric Coffee Pot .....	9.0 AMPS
Toaster .....	10.0 AMPS
Hair Dryer .....	10.0 AMPS
TV .....	2.0 AMPS
Dirt Devil Hand Vacuum .....	2.0 AMPS
Electric Fry Pan .....	10.0 AMPS
Iron .....	10.0 AMPS
Food Processor .....	6.0 AMPS
Crock Pot .....	1.5 AMPS
Heating Pad.....	.3 AMPS
